3. Expect
"When Sanballat heard that we were rebuilding the wall, he became angry and was greatly incensed. He ridiculed the Jews, ² and in the presence of his associates and the army of Samaria, he said, 'What are those feeble Jews doing? Will they restore their wall? Will they offer sacrifices? Will they finish in a day? Can they bring the stones back to life from those heaps of rubble – burned as they are?" Nehemiah 4:1-2 (NIV)
"Tobiah the Ammonite, who was at his side, said, 'What they are building – even a fox climbing up on it would break down their wall of stones!" Nehemiah 4:3 (NIV)
"They all plotted together to come and fight against Jerusalem and stir up trouble against it. ⁹ But we prayed to our God and posted a guard day and night to meet this threat." Nehemiah 4:8-9 (NIV)

"So we rebuilt the wall till all of it reached half its height, for the people worked with all their heart." Nehemiah 4:6 (NIV)
