John 10:1-18

Jesus – “I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.” John 10:11 (NIV)

Jesus – “Very truly I tell you Pharisees, anyone who does not enter the sheep pen by the gate, but climbs in by some other way, is a thief and a robber. ²The one who enters by the gate is the shepherd of the sheep.” John 10:1-2 (NIV)

Jesus – “The gatekeeper opens the gate for him, and the sheep listen to his voice. He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out.” John 10:3 (NIV)

Jesus – “When he has brought out all his own, he goes on ahead of them, and his sheep follow him because they know his voice. ⁵But they will never follow a stranger; in fact, they will run away from him because they do not recognize a stranger’s voice.” John 10:4-5 (NIV)

“Jesus used this figure of speech, but the Pharisees did not understand what he was telling them. ⁷Therefore Jesus said again, ‘Very truly I tell you, I am the gate for the sheep.’” John 10:6-7 (NIV)

Jesus – “All who have come before me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep have not listened to them.” John 10:8 (NIV)

Jesus – “I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved. They will come in and go out, and find pasture.” John 10:9 (NIV)
