1. **Kesad**...The Kesad of God is His steadfast, never ending love that is deeper and stronger than anyone can imagine.
 - Hosea Chapter 1: The Prophet Marries a Prostitute. They have three children together with strange names.
 - Hosea Chapter 2: The Holy Man's wife leaves him and her family to go back to being a prostitute.
 - Hosea Chapter 3: Hosea buys out his wife's prostitution contract and invites her home.
