“And hope does not disappoint us, because God has poured out his love into
our hearts by the Holy Spirit, whom he has given us.” Romans 5:5 (NIV)

“You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for
the ungodly. [v.7] Very rarely will anyone die for a righteous person, though for
a good person someone might possibly dare to die. [v.8] But God
demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ
